





Corporate Art Experiences

Enrich your visit to Grounds For Sculpture by participating in a Corporate Art Experience.

	<p>The Sculpture Hunt is a fun introduction to Grounds For Sculpture! An educator or Volunteer Docent will greet your group and give a brief orientation to the park and the activity. Your group will be split into smaller teams, who will compete to be the fastest team to find selected sculptures outdoors and complete the questions. This activity lasts approximately 1 hour and the members of the winning team receive a prize, normally a set of Grounds For Sculpture guest passes for each team member.</p>
	<p>Explore the 35-acre sculpture park and/or indoor exhibitions with trained Volunteer Docents and experience contemporary sculpture in a new light. The Docent-led Tour is approximately 1 hour in duration. Each docent can lead a group of 10-15 people, and multiple docents can be arranged.</p>
	<p>In the Found Object Sculpture Workshop, your group will have an artistic team-building experience. Working with an artist instructor, participants will repurpose a variety of found objects into a group sculpture based upon a theme brainstormed by your group. Objects will be provided and participants are encouraged to bring additional objects from work or home. Participants will look at objects in new ways and have a completed sculpture to keep. This workshop is 1-1.5 hours in length and can accommodate a maximum of 35 people.</p>
	<p>During the William King Inspired Sculpture Workshop, your group will learn about William King and visit his work in the park for inspiration. Participants will work with an artist instructor to create individual small-scale sculptures using wire, metal, and mesh. This workshop is 1 hour in length and can accommodate a maximum of 20 people.</p>
